The concept

Quai d'Été

- 3 to 13 July 2025
- Quai des Péniches, 1000 Brussels
- Free access all the canalside activities are free to access

Over eleven days, the City of Brussels is transforming Quai des Péniches into a popup homeport with a brand-new event: **Quai d'Été**.

The aim is to offer a getaway to people staycationing in the city, revitalize the newly renamed 'Kanal District' and provide a culture-packed, fun-filled alternative to everyone who makes it their destination.

The event has three components: **- Sport and relaxation**: cultural activities, mini golf, pétanque, activities for kids, Mölkky, urban tennis, trampoline, deckchairs...

 Pleasure cruises: aboard The Boat, daily Brussels DJ sets along the canal
 Food & drink: a bar with nonstop food services and chances to socialize

A familiar location, an unique atmosphere

Quai d'Été is inspired by the legacy of Bruxelles les Bains — a previous major event loved by locals and visitors from all corners — but with a **more modern** and **flexible approach**. Less beach, more port: containers, raw structures, murals and reclaimed furniture. The warm post-industrial feel reflects the area's soul.

The City of Brussels is therefore providing a more current and dynamic popup format to mark the start of summer, in keeping with the new 'Kanal District' environment and enabling its seamless integration into the canal banks. The beach has been replaced with a mini port.

The '**Summer Wonders**' concept now covers the summertime events staged by the nonprofit **Brussels Major Events** for the City of Brussels.

The dance-themed 'Summer Wonders' held in 2024 is back this year with the name '**Brussels Dance Festival**' from **14 to 24 August 2025**. More information coming in late June.

'Summer Wonders' brings together Quai d'Été and the Brussels Dance Festival on the same website, providing easy access to information on the various events: www.plaisirsdete.be.

Free canalside programming

Quai d'Été is your summertime destination in the heart of Brussels: deckchairs to rest up, a bar to drink up, kids activities, concerts, mini golf and folk dancing. Expect a refreshing, light-hearted atmosphere on the water. Get onboard with your crew and prepare to have a good time!

A free, inclusive and vibrant village

Quai d'Été comes to life in a raw but relaxed setting: refurbished containers, reclaimed furniture, deckchairs, parasols, frescoes and reinvented port fixtures... We come here to play, dance, discover, relax or simply have a drink.

Sports activities (mini golf, urban tennis, pétanque, trampoline), workshops for kids, spontaneous performances and chilled musical programming at the end of the day set the tempo on the canal banks. New categories are added every weekend (kids party, yoga, DJ sets...). "Spending summer in Brussels is choosing to stay in a fastmoving city. With Quai d'Été, we're providing a real opportunity for relaxation and entertainment to everyone staycationing here. Even in July, the city remains a popular destination."

From midday to nightfall (and a little later at weekends), the canalside is transformed into a giant playground:

- Mini golf, pétanque and trampoline
- Workshops for kids
- Chilled DJ sets at the end of the day
- Street art frescoes and reinvented port street furniture
- Yoga, sports activities and popup surprises

The aim isn't to imitate an artificial beach but to enhance a real place. A disused crane, barges, containers and street art serve as a backdrop to this summer escape in the heart of the city.

Programme (non-exhaustive):

- Monday to Saturday: 14:00–18:00 cultural activities and workshops
- Wednesday to Saturday: 17:00–22:00 chilled DJ sets
- Sunday: 9:00–15:00 activities during the new canalside market
- Sunday afternoon: kids party from 15:00 to 18:00







Every day, get onboard with a musical cruise along the canal.

The Boat becomes a floating dancefloor led by a fine selection of Brussels-based groups who know how to get the party started. Electro, funk, house or hip hop, the vibe changes every day but the destination remains the same: freedom and fun.

- Start in the city centre
- Live DJ sets, drinks onboard, dancing deck
- Views of the street art frescoes along the canal
- Indoor bar to relax and refresh
- A unique urban experience, designed as a daytrip

Whether you're canalside or aboard, The Boat invites you to see Brussels in a new light.

The Boat is setting sail for cruises coproduced with Brussels-based groups. Specialist DJ sets, drinks on the water, dance parties... An illuminated deck, the city as the backdrop and a canal providing the heartbeat of the summer.

- No refunds will be given, including for late arrivals or missed trips.

- The barge is not accessible to disabled people.

- Adult-only event (18 and over).

Sustainability and inclusivity

Quai d'Été is more than a series of open-air cultural activities. It's an event designed to be integrated naturally into its urban environment, emphasizing sustainability, inclusivity and accessibility. Far from the usual grand fare, it prioritizes short supply chains, close connections and a determination to welcome absolutely everyone.

A responsible initiative

Sustainability is at the heart of our organization. To limit our environmental impact, several measures are followed: – **Reusable tableware** to reduce waste production at the source;

- **Recycling onsite**, with visible schemes accompanied by clear signage. We're also encouraging the public to prioritize active or shared mobility for travel to the site.

Inclusive programming

The event is **largely free** so as to remain accessible to a wide audience. We're working closely with **local cultural operators**, emerging artists and grassroots associations to promote the initiatives already present in Brussels and facilitate local participation.

Accessibility

Disabled access to the space hosting canalside activities

The site is well served by public transport:

- Bus: routes 46, 88, 14, 20, 86
- Metro: lines 2 and 5
- **Tram**: line 25

For people travelling by car, two off-street **car parks (Interparking)** are located nearby:

- ZIN - Quartier Nord (Chaussée d'Anvers 59, 1000 Brussels)

- Brabant Gare du Nord (Rue de Quatrecht 38, 1030 Brussels)

On 3 July, summer starts in Brussels! To celebrate the debut of Quai d)Été, a unique launch party is coming to the canal banks. Performances, cruises, poetry and symbolic gestures will set the stage for a peaceful and joyful summer.

19:30 - Back to canalside and launch of the inaugural 'Free Your Summer'
20:00 - Departure of the second cruise onboard The Boat (open to the public by prior reservation — length: 2½ hours)
22:30 - Back to canalside

Passengers who want to board **The Boat** will be asked to arrive thirty minutes before departure.

No boarding will be permitted after the stated time.

The Quai d'Été poster

Like an **urban postcard**, the Quai d'Été poster offers escapism... without leaving Brussels.

A busy canalside, a pleasure boat, a firmly placed parasol: everything is there to suggest the promise of a gentle summer on the canal banks.

The Boat is a surprise: the visual evolves with a party scene against a setting sun, differentiating between the activities canalside and onboard. The white frame, inspired by Polaroids, anchors the image in a contemporary aesthetic: shared memories, moments captured on the spot and a changing city that's willing to be seen differently.

Colourful, bilingual, joyously simple and ever-changing, the visual captures the spirit of the event: **an inclusive and free summertime gathering for all locals** whether they come from the next street or the other side of the city.
